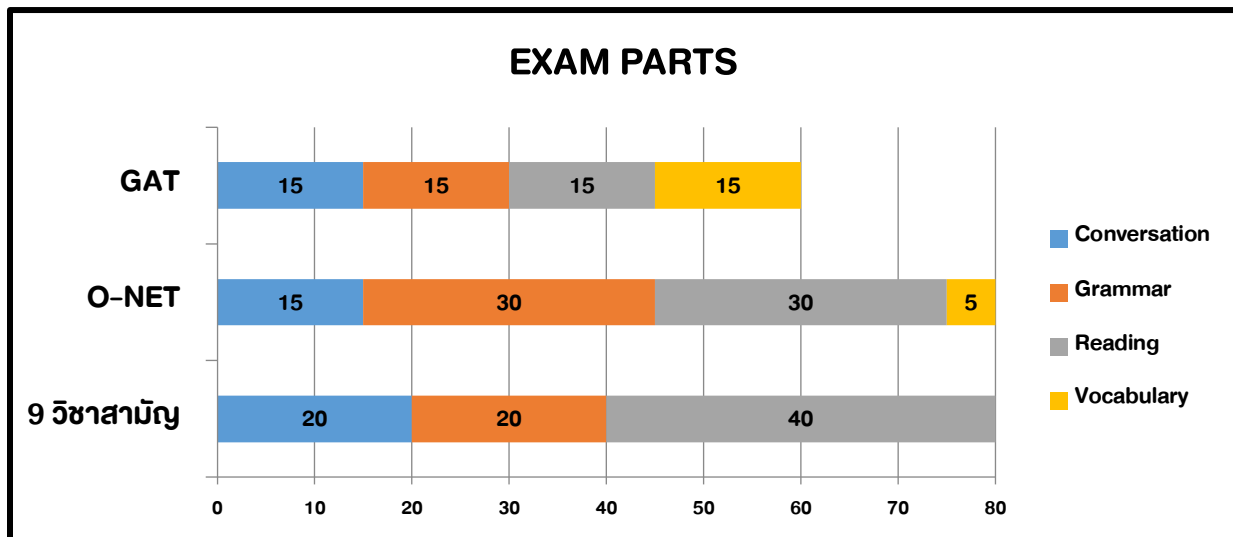

If three guys break into your house and you defend yourself with just your bare hands, it is clear to us that you haven't practiced real self-defense.

Real self-defense starts with weapons and works its way down the ladder to bare-handed techniques. Check out the news any day of the week and you will most likely hear of someone who has been shot dead or **assaulted** with some type of weapon. In comparison, very rarely will you hear of someone beaten to death by another person with just their bare hands. If your martial arts training is not addressing this, it is not preparing you for real violence or teaching you real self-defense.

If you are not sure whether the martial art you are learning teaches you real self-defense, ask yourself two simple questions: (1) Does my martial art train me to deal with multiple opponents? (2) Does my martial art train me to use and defend against modern day weapons that I would see on the street?

To survive real violence, you need a martial art that is designed for it, and that is what we do at *Real Defense*. Our mission statement is: “*We study violence to escape it, prevent it and if all else fails, utilize it ourselves to survive*”.
